Good news from the Transitional Pastor Search team.

The Transitional Pastor search team has recommended to Session to begin the hiring process for Jesse MacDonald as our Transitional Pastor. Jesse and his wife, Beth, currently live in their hometown of Kershaw, South Carolina. Jesse is ordained in the EPC (Evangelical Presbyterian Church) and will need approval by our Great Lakes Presbytery in ECO (A Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians) in order to take this position. Jesse and Beth will be visiting Fredericksburg July 16-19, looking at our housing options, and will be preaching a message July 18. Jesse and Beth interviewed with the search team and again with Session and staff. We are very excited to introduce you to our candidate.

We continue to ask for prayers as we navigate through Jesse's Presbytery interviews and contract negotiations.
