This past weekend four of us from FPC traveled to Ripley, Ohio for the spring meeting of Great Lakes Presbytery. More than fifty other ECO church leaders were there as we worshiped, prayed, learned and met together to encourage one another and to do the business of the Presbytery.

After being in a Presbyterian church for almost twenty years, I have noticed that we often don't do a great job explaining what presbyteries are and why our churches are organized into them. Let me tell you a little bit about presbyteries and why I think they are awesome.

In traditional Presbyterianism, a presbytery is the comprised of the congregations and pastors from the churches of a set geographic area. Presbyteries are governed by the gathering of ordained teaching elders (pastors) and ruling elders (session members). In ECO there are 22 presbyteries. Our church is a member of the Great Lakes Presbytery which comprises all the fourteen ECO churches in Michigan and Ohio.

In our denomination (ECO) presbyteries have a certain set of responsibilities. Presbyteries are covenant communities that exercise authority over pastors and congregations so that they can flourish in building disciples. Specifically, this means that the presbytery has the duty to receive, dismiss, care for and discipline congregations and pastors. ECO presbyteries do this work through a set of teams comprised of pastors and elders who connect with, care for, serve and offer guidance to their churches and ordained ministers.

Here are the three biggest reasons I think being a part of a presbytery is AWESOME:

- **Connection** We aren't in this alone. We have more than a dozen other churches and pastors who are part of our faith family. That means we can hear about what they are doing, and share about our joys and struggles and get wisdom, feedback and insight from other experts and friends.
- **Support** It is good to know that when churches in our presbytery are facing challenges, other churches are there to help care and assist. Many times in our presbytery we have shared money, resources and time to help other churches; and they will do the same for us when/if we are ever in need.
- **Accountability** I am so glad to have other pastors and leaders to help us stay on mission and be focused on what God has called us to do. Being accountable means we are known, encouraged and challenged if needed. Every church can benefit from the accountability that comes from being in a covenant order of other congregations.

If you ever want to know more about our presbytery, or if you have never attended a presbytery meeting and would like to – let me know. You won't be disappointed!

CHURCH DIRECTORY UPDATE

For those of you that have been using the CTRN Online Directory App, we just received updated information from the company regarding this app. If you had the original app downloaded and were using it to access FPC directory information, you may find that it is not working anymore OR that it is giving you problems. That original app has been "retired" and will eventually not function for you - even if it is working currently. If you aren't sure which app you have - the old app had a white background and listed the words CTRN Directory below it. The new, current app for our directory has a dark blue background and says Online Member Directory below the app. There are a couple options you have in continuing to use the CTRN online directory:

1. Download the new updated App from the App Store. It is called Online Member Directory App. This would be the easiest and smoothest operation of using the directory. It has a dark blue background and looks like this:



If you do not want to download the app on your phone, you can also access the directory instantly from your mobile browser and bookmark the link for future visits to the site. To use this options you would type into your browser: http://fredericksburgpres.ctm.co

The directory will pop up. All our same data is secure and available just as it was with the old app. Apparently these apps become outdated and with new technology, it's necessary to use updated "apps" that work with all the fast changing technology.
