**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

He is risen, indeed!

I have sometimes found myself pondering what the time after the first Easter Sunday was like for the disciples of Jesus. The Scripture doesn't record very many stories of the forty days between Jesus' resurrection and His ascension into heaven; but we get the sense that Jesus was coming and going. Sometimes He was eating a meal with His followers or taking walks or doing more teaching. We even know that at some point in those handful of weeks He appeared to a crowd of more than 500 people.

But I wonder if His disciples were in shock at what had happened; were they slowly putting together the pieces of the cross and the empty tomb? Were they worried about what was going to happen next? In the final hours before the cross they had all abandoned Him; might they have been ashamed at the way they had left Him alone? Or were they eager? Maybe they were anticipating what amazing acts the resurrected Jesus was going to do next? Maybe it was all of the above and more.

There is, however, one common reaction that the gospels record: the disciples begin to worship Christ. There is something about the resurrected Jesus that caused the people who knew Him best to begin to praise and honor Him as God. This was a significant act in the Jewish culture, because only YAHWEH was to be worshipped – remember the second commandment? Somehow, the disciples began to slowly realize that Jesus IS God himself and choose to respond to that realization in worship.

We get to do the same thing. Following the reminders of this season of Lent and Holy Week, we again can join with those first disciples and renew our commitment to the worship of the risen Savior. How will you worship Jesus this week?

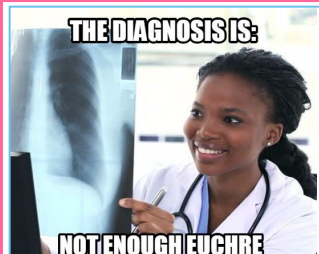
