All hands on deck! Mark your calendars! Get Ready! VBS is returning to FPC!!

The Children's Ministry team has been hard at work planning and preparing to bring VBS back this summer. We have a great curriculum, wonderful leadership and now we need you!

As we start promoting and sharing about VBS we want to remind everyone why we do it in the first place – there are three key reasons why a church would want to invest itself in Vacation Bible School.

- First and most importantly we want kids to know the good news of Jesus! Children can be fully
 -devoted followers of Christ, And VBS is a great way to cultivate faith among young ones so that
 they can know and believe that Jesus is King!
- Second we want to serve our community. Kids need spaces where they can experience love, connection and care. Building bridges between children and the church is a way to meet that need.
- Lastly if FPC is going to thrive into the future, we need to be making more connections with kids and young families. The truth is, we must make it a priority to know and connect with young people and those who love them. VBS is a key strategy for meeting people in our community and inviting them to learn more about Fredericksburg Presbyterian Church.

In order to accomplish these goals, we NEED EVERYONE TO JOIN IN! If you are part of the FPC family, there are three essential things you can do to make VBS a success:

- 1. PRAY! All of us can be praying for VBS! Let's ask God to be helping our leadership prepare. Ask God to raise up the volunteers and support that we need. Ask God to bring children from around our community to participate. And critically ask God to use VBS to help kids know and love Jesus!
- 2. INVITE! Who do you know that can come to VBS? Maybe you have kids or grandkids who could join us. Maybe there are neighbors with children; or coworkers who have kids that might like to come. All of us know children in and around the community let's ask them to join us! You never know who might be ready to say "yes"!
- 3. PARTICIPATE! We need help from all of us! There is a place for everyone to serve. We need people to help set-up and tear-down. We need folks to help with planning and preparing behind the scenes. We need people to help with supplies, crafts, snacks and materials. We need folks to hang out with kids, be helpers at VBS and connect with parents. There is something for everyone. YOUR FIRST STEP IS TO LET US KNOW YOUR WILLINGNESS AND AVAILABILITY! 

I pray that your love will overflow more and more in the children I serve, and that they will keep on growing in knowledge and understanding.




