It's been a few months since we've shared an update about the work the session has been doing lately, among the topics of conversation and action at this week's meeting were:

- Reviewed and shared feedback on our summer events and activities

 Stained Glass window talk approximately 50 in attendance

- Discussed plans for fall, including our "FPC Basics", (you'll be hearing more about this in September!)
- Voted to support the possible installation at the community park of a pickleball court and a basketball court paid for by the township trustees

You will also find in this weekly update a basic outline of current church finances. We think it's important for the congregation to be regularly informed about numbers related to budget and giving. We plan to share these amounts once a month in the weekly update that comes out after our session meeting.

Though the elders are a governing board, the most important job they do is to pray for our congregation and consider how God wants us to grow, serve and represent Him in our community.
