DECEMBER Weekly Update December 18, 2024

From the Pastor's Desk

A week from today (Wednesday, December 18) will be Christmas Day. We will be celebrating the arrival of the Christ child at His birth. But this means we still have a whole week to prepare during Advent.

Tish Harrison Warren is an award-winning author, Anglican priest and sometimes columnist for the New York Times and Christianity Today – she will also be speaking at January's ECO National Gathering. She has written and spoken a lot about the season of Advent. (here's a link to a 2019 column she wrote in the Times – <u>"Want to get into the Spirit of Christmas? Face the Darkness".</u>

Tish talks about how in the season of Advent, we do three different kinds of waiting. First, we wait along with the characters of the gospel stories and the people of the Old Testament, as they anticipate and hope for the coming of the Messiah. As we wait for Christmas, we remember the waiting of those first people of faith, whose waiting was rewarded with the coming of the infant Jesus. This is waiting of the past.

We also wait for the Second Advent of Jesus. During this season we consider and contemplate the promised return of Jesus. We wait with eager confidence that the savior is going to come again, and we long for His work to set all things right, dry every tear, and bring the New Creation we desperately desire. This is waiting for the future.

But there is a third kind of waiting we do during Advent. We are waiting for Jesus to show up in our lives here and now. We need Jesus to come into our everyday circumstances. We need Him to bring wisdom, to bring healing, to bring insight and discernment. We need Jesus to come and bring peace and comfort and hope in hard times. We need Jesus now. And so, we wait for Him in our everyday lives, to make His presence and ministry known. This is waiting in the present.

For this final week of Advent, I would encourage you to consider these different kinds of waiting and to contemplate our need for Jesus. If you haven't yet, set aside some moments this week and talk to God. Tell Him about your thankfulness that He has come in the past, your hope that He will come again in the future, and your desire to see Him work here in the present.

Don't rush into Christmas this week, but invest in the important spiritual work for preparing for the arrival of our King.
