Greetings Friends,

What do you remember about Barnabas?

I told a part of his story three weeks ago when we dove into Acts 11. In this story Barnabas traveled to Antioch to see the way that God was calling the Gentiles to faith there. Barnabas realized he was going to need to stay and lend support, so he traveled to Tarsus and brought Saul back to Antioch. They ministered together for an entire year.

There are a few other snapshots of Barnabas scattered throughout Acts. In Acts 4, we meet Joseph, the apostle from Cyprus who everyone called **Barnabas** because it means "son of encouragement." Barnabas was an encourager! In Acts 9, when the Jerusalem disciples were afraid of Saul, Barnabas drew closer. He met with Saul, heard his story, and then brought him back before the apostles, where Saul found acceptance.

For a while Paul and Barnabas were the dynamic duo. Traveling together to spread the Gospel. Until Acts 15, when they have a "sharp disagreement" and part ways over John Mark. Barnabas wanted to include John Mark in their work, but Paul didn't think it was wise because of a previous incident. Isn't it just like Barnabas to insist on giving John Mark a second chance?

He encourages and develops immature believers. It is an essential characteristic of Barnabas. What a "surprise" to see someone hang in there in messy relationships. What a gift to befriend the discarded and to help them grow. May that be something that we emulate. May we grow to see the possibilities that God has embedded in all the people we meet! A good lesson from the life of Barnabas.

Just two more weeks left in this *Surprise the World* adventure. Let's embrace this message and do some things that are outside of our normal routine. God is always at work, let's look and listen for signs of where we can join Him.
