


Pastor Nancy's News and Notes

Hello FPC,

What a surprise! Mary and the gals arrived at the tomb to find an angel who appeared like "lightning," with clothes white as snow, sitting on the stone. *He is not here; he has risen, just as he said (Matt 28:6).* Jesus may have told them in advance, but they were still surprised. It was unexpected, disorienting. The text says the women were *afraid*, yet filled with joy.

This is the story that we are invited into. Surprise! Good news! The grace of our Lord was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus (1 Tim 1:14). This reality overshadows all the other parts of our lives. When we live as people filled-up with the grace of God, full of faith and love, people we meet may notice. The Easter surprise translates into questionable lives where we become godly, intriguing, socially adventurous and joyous people - which feels surprising (and refreshing) in 2023, with all the division, disillusionment, and difficulty.

So let's join together for a 5 week series called "Surprise the World" where we will cultivate five practices to help us live intriguing, abundant lives that spill over to those around us.

I invite you to pick up a copy of the short book *Surprise the World* on Sunday. If you already have a copy, feel free to crack it open and start reading. Then on Sunday, stay after worship, for "Table Talk" in the Fellowship Hall during the second hour.

May we feel the "surprise" that all things are new and possible because of Jesus.
