From the Pastor's Desk

I had a bit of a freakout moment last week. I flipped my wall calendar from April to May. OH MY WORD, IT'S ALREADY MAY - WHY IS 2025 FLYING BY? Am I the only one who feels like they blinked and it's almost summer? Since it is the beginning of May, that means it has been three months since we had our congregational meeting and laid out a number of things we would be working on this year, so I wanted to take an opportunity with the newsletter article this week to update you on some of things we discussed in that meeting.

First – we let you know that we have completed the first major steps in preparing to hire a part-time director of music and worship. A job description has been written and approved and a search team has been formed. The search team consists of two elders, two representatives from the music team and two at-large congregation members. The team will be meeting soon and will be posting our job opportunity in the coming weeks. You can expect to hear more updates about the search as it progresses. Please pray for this search, and when you see the job posted, please share as you feel appropriate!

Second – I'm sure you have heard that VBS is coming back to FPC this summer. The kids ministry team is a devoted, hard-working and faithful bunch of people who are eager to reach kids with the good news of King Jesus. We hope this helps us make more connections with young folks and families in our area. WE NEED YOUR HELP WITH THIS! We need volunteers, decorations, prayers, and most importantly, we need your help to invite kids to join us. Here is a specific thing you can pray for – the team has gotten permission to share flyers for VBS and other activities for Fredericksburg kids with ALL the kids in several area grade schools!!! Please pray that these flyers are seen by parents and adults and that we will have new faces joining us for VBS!

Third - God has richly blessed our church with amazing ministry leaders, a beautiful building, faithful covenant partners and healthy finances – so now it's time to use those things to make disciples! We are in the middle of a sermon series encouraging us to invest in connections with other people – to have spiritual conversations that create opportunities for disciple-making. We will be emphasizing these kinds things throughout the rest of year. We are doing this because we are a blessed church who can use those blessings to join God on His mission. We are all privileged to share in the responsibility of building the church through reaching others with the good news of Jesus. How are you sensing God's prodding to show hospitality to those who aren't already part of our church family?

Fourth – Even with all this movement forward, we remain committed to caring for each other and faithfully attending to the covenant partners of FPC. Our deacons have worked hard to organize themselves to have connections with every church member; our elders pray for each and every one of you by name each month; we will continue to worship authentically, administer the sacraments rightly, teach God's word joyfully and care for the membership with all the grace and love God gives us.

I hope that you are as enthusiastic and blessed about the future of FPC's people and ministry as I am! God is working in our midst, and it's a blessing to keep reaching for God's will in the life of our church!


