

In college I joined the Tae Kwon Do club. To this day, I'm not sure why I signed up for it, other than my friends were doing it and it seemed like fun. I knew absolutely NOTHING about martial arts in general, let alone Tae Kwon Do. I was starting at the very beginning. Slowly I progressed and learned how to do different kinds of kicks and blocks. We were taught forms and stretches and even how to count to ten in Korean. I started feeling like I was getting the hang of it; so I was ready to ditch my white belt for the next one. I told the instructor I was ready to test for my yellow belt; I told him I didn't want to be a beginner anymore.

This was a mistake.

I got a very stern talking to – we are ALL beginners he told me, even the black belt is just beginning to understand Tae Kwon Do. The best student, he lectured, is always learning and perfecting the basics; you never move past them.

I don't know if he was right about Tae Kwon Do (I was done with the club after one year) – but I think what he said is right about the spiritual life.

This Sunday we completed our FPC Basics series. For many weeks this fall we explored the key ways we, as covenant partners of FPC, can nurture the spiritual growth God wants to do in our lives and in our church.

These basics matter, because we never grow out of them! All of us can commit to the basics and can keep deepening our commitment to love, know, represent, experience and share God.

It's my hope that all of us may pick a few of these "basics" and work to grow in them over the coming weeks and months. Stretch into something new for yourself – maybe attend Second Hour, or consider volunteering with one of our ministries, or reach out to a friend with words of encouragement. There are so many ways to take one more step on the road to deepening and strengthening our walk with Jesus.

I sincerely believe we will grow as Jesus-followers and our church will grow as a community when we take the basics seriously! We will be happily surprised when we do the things we can – worship, learn, serve, pray and build friendships – God does the things He can do: make us more like Jesus.

 Be involved in an experience of regular spiritual nurture (eg: Second Hour, GLOW, Bible Study, the Grind, etc.)


